Please accept this letter as a notice of my retirement, effective August 1, 2024.



Special Board Report

With the district reductions, we will be losing one math position to retirement. The high school currently requires 2 more credits than the state requirement for math.

I am requesting to reduce the math credits by 2 credits to match the state requirement of 6 credits for math. This change would have to begin during the 2024-2025 school year.

We will continue to have students in next year's 9-12 needing 7 credits of math to match the requirements, not all but some. This will be worked out with Lael when we build the course schedule for next year.

I am also requesting that we keep the current graduation credit requirement at 47 credits with no reduction.
