NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING TO DISCUSS BUDGET AND PROPOSED TAX RATE

The LaVega Independent School District will hold a public meeting at 12:00 PM, September 29, 2005 in the LaVega Administration Building, 3100 Bellmead Dr, Bellmead TX 76705. The purpose of this meeting is to discuss the school district's budget that will determine the tax rate that will be adopted. Public participation in the discussion is invited.

The tax rate that is ultimately adopted at this meeting or at a separate meeting at a later date may not exceed the proposed rate shown below unless the district publishes a revised notice containing the same information and comparisons set out below and holds another public meeting to discuss the revised notice.

* The Interest & Sinking Fund tax revenue is used to pay for bonded indebtedness on construction, equipment, or both. The bonds, and the tax rate necessary to pay those bonds, were approved by the voters of this district.

Under state law, the dollar amount of school taxes imposed on the residence homestead of a person 65 years of age or older or of the surviving spouse of such a person, if the surviving spouse was 55 years of age or older when the person died, may not be increased above the amount paid in the first year after the person turned 65, regardless of changes in tax rate or property value.

Notice of Rollback Rate: The highest tax rate the district can adopt before requiring voter approval at an election is \$1.790661. This election will be automatically held if the district adopts a rate in excess of the rollback rate of \$1.790661.

Background Information:

The 2005-2006 Budget is partially supported by local tax revenue; specifically, the General Fund and the Debt Service Funds. The Board adopted tax rates on August 30, 2005, based on information then available, to support these funds. Since that time, the district has confirmed the availability of additional state funding for facilities. It is now in the best interest of the district and its taxpayers to amend the original tax rates. The attached resolution sets forth the recommended amended tax rates for Maintenance and Operation (General Fund) and Debt Service (Interest and Sinking Fund). These tax rates have been advertised, and a public hearing has been conducted on the proposed amended rates.

Fiscal Implication:

The General Fund tax rate adopted on August 30 was \$1.5000, and the recommended Debt Service tax rate is \$.2975, for a total tax rate of \$1.7975. The amended rates, as advertised in the Waco Tribune-Herald on September 22, 2005, reflect a General Fund tax rate of \$1.5000, and a Debt Service tax rate of \$.1925, for a total amended tax rate of \$1.6925.

Administrative Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Board adopt an amended tax rate of \$1.5000 for Maintenance and Operations and \$.1925 for Debt Service, for a total amended tax rate of \$1.6925, as detailed in the attached resolution.

Background Information:

The district has been converting all telephone systems to Voice Over Internet Protocol (VOIP) from stand-alone phone systems for the past several years. The equipment that manages this system is in need of upgrade in order to expand and continue to manage the expanded call volume. In addition, we have begun to experience some downtime due to the age of the equipment (5+ years). The total cost of this upgrade is \$25,393. In light of the significant cost, we have investigated lease-purchase of the equipment over a two-year period. This will enable us to spread the budget impact over the life of the equipment.

Fiscal Implication:

The proposed lease cost is \$26,812.64, or 8 quarterly payments of \$3,351.58. The total interest cost would be \$1,419.64. More important, the impact on the 2005-06 budget would be \$10,054.74. Sufficient funds are included in the budget to cover this amount.

Administrative Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Board approve the lease-purchase of Voice Over IP telephone equipment from Key Government Finance, Inc. for the principal amount of \$25,393 and interest of \$1,419.64.
