The administration alleges that they have failed to send report cards out at the end of the school year as directed by the Principal, failed to turn in instructional material to the Instructional Facilitator, failed to account for library materials he had checked out in October 2005, failed to pack up their personal and professional materials in their assigned room to be moved to the new campus, failed to check out at the end of the year with the administrative ataff as directed, failed to return phone calls, failed to attend two workshops that they agreed to attend in the summer that LVISD paid for based on their agreement to attend and has refused to contact Mr. Bishop, Executive Director of Personnel, regarding a solution to these problems. After discussion with Mr. John Aldridge of the District's law firm of Walsh. Anderson, Brown, Schulze and Aldridge, it has reached a point where we have no confidence that this teacher's conduct will be in an acceptable professional manner for the coming school year.
