The District's funds are required to be deposited and invested under the terms of a depository contract pursuant to the School Depository Act and under the guidelines of the Public Funds Investment Act. American Bank of Waco deposits for safekeeping and trust with the District's agent, bank-approved pledged securities in an amount sufficient to protect District funds on a day-to-day basis during the period of the contract.

On December 31, 2021, the balance of the district's bank deposits were \$1,437,881 and \$1,119,997 for the Maintenance and Operations and Interest and Sinking funds, respectively. These balances were covered by FDIC insurance and by collateral held by the District's agent in the District's name. The District's cash balances were properly collateralized or insured at all times during the quarter.

Cash balances are held by American Bank, TexasTERM and Texas Class. The following is a summary of each pooled fund group's interest earnings for the first ten-months of the fiscal year, as well as the budgetary comparison:

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





RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the recent inclement weather resulted in the closure of all schools and facilities in the La Vega Independent School District ("La Vega ISD") on February 3, 2022, through February 4, 2022, (a total of two work days) due to dangerous travel conditions, power outages, and for the safety of students and staff and the community as a whole;

WHEREAS employees who are instructed not to report to work may suffer a loss of pay unless the workdays are made up at a later date. The Board concludes that continuing wage payments to all regular employees, contractual and noncontractual, salaried and non-salaried, during the emergency closing caused by inclement weather serves the public purposes of ensuring safety of staff and students, maintaining morale, reducing turnover, and ensuring continuity of District staffing when schools reopen.

Now therefore it be resolved by the Board that:

- 1. All of the above-referenced paragraphs are incorporated into and made part of this resolution; and
- 2. The Board determines that the District will not require employees to make up work days missed due to closure of school facilities or operations as a result of inclement on February 3, 2022, through February 4, 2022; and

The Board finds that a public purpose and a benefit to the LVISD exists to compensate LVISD employees for three work days missed due to closure of school facilities or operations as a result of inclement weather, and that this expenditure is necessary in the conduct of the public schools as provided by Texas Education Code § 45.105(c); and
- 4. The Board hereby authorizes the Superintendent to identify employees and absences covered by this Resolution, and to take any and all action necessary to fulfill the purposes of this Resolution.
